---REQUIREMENTS---

The requirements listed below reflect the undergraduate major curricular changes approved by the Catalog Subcommittee since approval of the last Undergraduate Major Change Bulletin. All curricula are printed in their entirety under the headings Current and Proposed, respectively. The column to the far right indicates the date each change becomes effective.

Molecular Biosciences, new undergraduate certificate	--N/A--	The certificate in molecular biosciences requires a minimum of 18 hours. Students are expected to have already completed courses equivalent to one year of freshman chemistry for science majors; one year of freshman biology for science majors; and one semester of organic chemistry; all through an accredited institution of higher education before working towards this certificate. The 15 hour core is: MBioS 101 or 305 and 306; MBioS 301; MBioS 303; and Phil 260. 3 hours of electives are selected from: Anth 468, Biol 330, Crm J 320, MBioS 130, 320, or 342. A grade of C or better must be earned in all classes that apply towards this certificate. Most of the courses required for this certificate have prerequisites. Please consult the catalog to assure that these prerequisites have been met prior to registering for courses.	1-10
