One business | The minor in construction management requires a minimum of 17 hours, 9 of which must be upper-division and taken in residence at WSU or through WSUapproved education abroad or educational exchange courses. To be eligible to apply for the minor a student must have Arch 101 or approved drawing course, certification in any major, and minimum gpa of 2.70. The minor is limited to 10 students per year. | Interior Design, revise certification requirements | Students wishing to certify into the Bachelor of Arts in Interior Design program must complete a minimum of 45 semester hours and receive a C or better in the following eight courses: I D 101, 102, 197, 201, 203, 205, 215, 297, or transfer equivalents as approved by the department. Upon completion of ID 203, students' GPAs are used to determine certification into the major in Interior Design. | Students wishing to certify into the Bachelor of Arts in Interior Design program must complete a minimum of 45 semester hours. Of those 45 semester hours, 29 semester hours ( 26 for transfer students) are major specific courses (I D 101, 102, 197, 201, 202, 203, 205, 215, 297, or transfer equivalents as approved by the department) in which the student must receive a C or better. Upon completion of ID 203, students' GPAs are used to determine certification into the major in Interior Design. The student's overall WSU GPA and major specific GPA from the courses listed above are considered. While students must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA to apply for certification, the process is competitive due to limited space in upper division courses.
