| Human Development drop certificate option in Preschool through Third Grade (P-3) | Human Development - Preschool through Third Grade (P-3) Certification Option (131 Hours) <br> Feaching Certificate Program-Students majoring in human development may choose to become certified in the state of Washington to teach in preschool through third grade ( $\mathrm{P}-3$ ), and kindergarten through eighth grade ( $K-8$ ), or family and consumer sciences. They must fulfill course requirements specified by the state of Washington. Note that the certification programs available in human development are offered in conjunction with the WSUCollege of Education. Additionally, those teacher certification students who wish to have a supporting endorsement from the Department of Human Development must meet with the appropriate human development advisor to obtain the list of approved courses. <br> The Bachelor of Arts degree in Human Development requires a cumulative gpa of 2.5 or better and a $C$ minimum grade in all HD courses, including substitutions.
