The requirements listed below reflect the undergraduate major curricular changes approved by the Catalog Subcommittee since approval of the last Undergraduate Major Change Bulletin. All changes are underlined. Deletions are crossed out. The column to the far right indicates the date each change becomes effective.

Economic Sciences Revise Minor in Economics	Economics To be eligible to certify in an economics minor, students must have a cumulative 2.0 gpa. A minor in economics requires 18 hours of ECONS courses, nine of which must be at the 300–400–level with an overall 2.0 gpa in the required courses and taken in residence at WSU or through WSU–approved education abroad or educational exchange courses. ECONS 101 and 102 (or 198 and a 300/400–level ECONS courses), and 302 or 320 are required. In addition, ECONS 301 or 305, and two-one	8-13
	300-level or higher ECONS electives and one 300/400-level or higher ECONS elective are required (only three hours of ECONS 497 or 499 may be used to fulfill the upper-division ECONS electives requirement). Only ECONS 497 or 499 may be taken pass, fail.
