Each certificate reflects a high standard of training and experience in a specific area of human development. Non-human development majors are required to complete any prerequisites for the internship requirement. The requirements for each certificate include 6 hours in H D core courses that support the area of certification, 15 hours in required and optional courses and 4 hours of internship that reflect the area of certification.
